The following questions have been used successfully by various Rotary Club RYLA Interviewers.

1. What do you know about Rotary? Do you personally know any Rotarians?
2. What do you know about RYLA? Have you talked with a prior RYLA attendee?
3. What do you believe makes a good leader?
4. Either living or dead, who do you think has proven to be a good leader and why?
5. Give an example of someone you personally know who is a good leader and why?
6. Have you ever been in a leadership role? When? How? Result?
7. What characteristics do you believe an effective leader should have?

(For the following questions, refer to the applicant's written essay)

8. Tell us about your school and community activities.
9. What do you consider your greatest service achievement and why?
10. Tell us about your school grades. What are your best subjects?
11. If you could change something about your school or community, what would it be? How would you go about making the change?
12. What are some of your short term and long-term goals?
13. Do you plan on accepting a leadership role in your senior year? Why that club or organization?
14. Why do you want to attend RYLA?
